Responsibilities

Duties and responsibilities include:

- assisting in the development of job exposure profiles
- traveling independently to remote worksites to identify and assess health risks
- monitoring worker exposures to substances harmful to health
- participating in Emergency Response events if health risk is identified
- entering exposure data into the Medgate Health Management Information System
- participating in additional projects as needed

Qualifications

- legally entitled to work in Canada for the duration of their work term
- available for a 4 month term, starting in May 2010
- enrolled in Bachelor's or Master's degree in Occupational Hygiene; note that preference will be given to those who have completed a BSc and are working towards a Master's degree with occupational hygiene specialization
- strong working knowledge of occupational health and safety legislation in Alberta
- demonstrated competency in exposure assessment methodologies and control principles
- ability to function effectively in an Oil and Gas Production operating environment and its associated risks and stressors
- proficiency in computer software applications, specifically Microsoft Office
